Betty Haile Memorial Scholarship

Background:

The Betty Haile Memorial scholarships are given in honor and memory of Norman educator Betty M. Haile, a long time teacher in the Norman Public Schools. She was a senior English teacher at Norman North High School at the time of her death. Mrs. Haile was dedicated to her students and their education. The two scholarships were set up by her family to recognize the efforts students put forth in continuing their education. The scholarships are for those who plan to continue their education at a college-university or a vocational school (i.e., Moore Norman Vo-Tech, Cosmetology School, Metro-Tech, Mid-America Technology Institute. **This scholarship application is for those who plan to attend a college-university.** Scholarship monies will be awarded upon proof of enrollment at the post high school institution.

Application Requirements:

Applicants must submit the following information in order to apply for this scholarship:

- The application in its entirety, including a 500-word essay
- Applicant and parent signatures and date
- Verifiable financial indicators of economic need
- Current High School Transcript
- Two teacher recommendations

Scholarship Details:

The Betty Haile Memorial Scholarship awards \$1,500 each year. The goal of the Scholarship is to award one (1) \$1,000 scholarship for a Norman North High School senior going to college and one (1) \$500 scholarship for a Norman North High School senior going to a technical institute.

Application Due Date:

Completed applications must be returned to Ms. Perry's office no later than **Friday, March 5, 2010.**

The application must be filled out in ink or you may type the questions and answers on a separate sheet (or sheets) of paper. If you choose to type your application, it must be attached to the original application form.
